PATTERN OF PRAYER

For each of our focus areas, we have a three fold pattern of prayer:

- **Thank You.** Expressing our gratitude to God for his faithfulness and provision.
- **Sorry.** Repenting for our sin and the ways we fall short. Includes lament for the brokenness of our lives and world—the damage we do/experience.
- **Please.** Seeking God's will for our lives, church, and world. Entrusting our requests to God and trusting his will.

AREA ONE: WORLD

Persecuted Church & Global Mission

God is active in the world, drawing people to himself through his Son and in the power of his Spirit. Ever since the inception of the church, Christians have faced persecution. For more information on how to pray for the persecuted church, visit Open Doors (opendoors.org.au).

THANK YOU

- For the faithful witness of Christians across time and place, especially for those facing persecution.
- For the significant growth of the church in many places in the world in which it is dangerous to believe.
- For how the gospel is going out to remote and isolated places. Give thanks for how the Bible is being brought to people in different languages and dialects.
- For the opportunity for the Church particularly in regions of war and unrest, to reflect God's true peace.

- That even in the face of persecution *that you are present with every believer.*

SORRY

- For when we forget the plight of the persecuted church.
- For our inconsistency of praying for the mission of the global church, especially in those places that face persecution and the threat of persecution for their faith.
- For when we fail to grasp the significance of the Gospel opportunities that we have in Australia and on our frontlines.
- We lament all forms of persecution of Christians and the church.

PLEASE

- Please protect and give strength to those who face any type of persecution and suffering. Provide for them according to their needs.
- Protect, nurture, and give strength to the underground church in Algeria, Libya, Iran, Afghanistan, and China.
- Release Christians who face false blasphemy accusations in Pakistan.
- For Christians in the Middle East, for protection and peace. Pray that the church would be witness to the true peace that Christ brings.
- For Christians in India who are being pressured heavily to deny Jesus.
- For Christians who have been imprisoned, that God's Word will be a constant source of comfort.
- For peace and safety for Christians in Nigeria facing hostile attacks and for over 300 believers currently facing

terrorism changes because of their faith in Jesus.

- For the families of the 50 people recently killed in the Democratic Rep. of Congo and for 31,600 people currently displaced through hostility.
- For perseverance for those Muslim-background believers in Iraq.
- Equip local believers with perseverance to face hostility, and bring Christ's mercy and compassion to all situations.
- For Christians arrested in North Korea, for God to be their refuge, and for his peace that passes all understanding to be present with them and their families.
- For the guards, interrogators, and North Korean officials, that they will be touched by the witness of Christians, and turn to Christ.
- Move the global church to be generous to those who are most vulnerable.
- To sustain believers who have been physically harmed and/or isolated for becoming followers of Jesus.
- To sustain, protect, and guide local church leaders, particularly when they have been displaced and facing pressure.
- For boldness and wisdom for believers to share their faith and that people would come to Christ.
- That entire communities would encounter Christ through the testimony of men, women, and children who refuse to give up - even when it costs them everything.
- Move us from apathy to lives shaped by faithful and persistent prayer.

AREA TWO: OUR CITY & OUR NATION

Our City & Our Nation

The Lord cares for the people we live amongst and our nation. Pray we would be faithful in serving the Lord on our frontlines, and committed to contributing to and praying for our city and our nation.

THANK YOU

- For our nation Australia, for the abundance of natural beauty and resources, and for the many opportunities given to people.
- For those who serve our nation in federal, state, and local governments, in both elected and non-elected roles, working towards the good of society.
- For those who serve our communities as public-servants, for those creating and sustaining local businesses, and those working in the non-for-profit sector.
- For our cities of Toowoomba and Brisbane, and the broader regions of the Darling Downs, and South Brisbane.
- For the diversity of cultures and people groups, who live, work, study, and play in Rangeville & Salisbury.

SORRY

- For when we have failed to pray for our city and our nation.
- For when we have failed to see our role in contributing to society.
- For when we have offered criticism, without first looking to encourage.
- For when we have prioritised our needs, above the needs of our neighbour.
- For when we are quick to judge, and don't take the time to understand.
- For our blindness to injustice not addressed or perpetuated.

PLEASE

- Give wisdom and compassion to our leaders of all levels of government, and give courage to make important long-term decisions and priorities that will benefit future generations.
- Heal divisions in our society, and help us grow in tolerance and understanding of each other. Please shape our society in accordance with your love, compassion, forgiveness, justice, and mercy.
- Protect the most vulnerable in our city and in our nation. Please grow our generosity towards those who are in need of food, a home, friendship, and understanding.
- Sustain and strengthen emergency workers and first responders supporting communities facing natural disasters.
- Please provide comfort for those who are grieving, and practical support for those in need.

AREA THREE: TOOWOOMBA & BRISBANE

Frontlines including Workplaces

Our work, places of work, and those with whom we work, all matter to God. This term we are praying with a focus on *gospel-shaped families in cross-cultural settings.*

THANK YOU

- For the dignity of work and for the ways in which we can serve God's mission through what we do, where we serve, and with whom we work.
- Thank you for the opportunities through work we have to model godly character, make good work, minister grace and love, mould culture, be a mouthpiece for truth and justice, and be messengers of the gospel.
- For the multitude of people who serve behind the scenes, often in areas of work that are critical for our society.
- For those committed to training, apprenticing, and developing people.

SORRY

- For when we neglect our workplaces, fail to pray for our colleagues, or are

hesitant to embrace Gospel opportunities before us.

- For when we skim on our commitments or let colleagues down.
- For when we evaluate people (and ourselves) by the work that we do.
- For the ways we are blind to the service of others through their work.
- We lament the brokenness of some workplaces, the challenge it is for many, and imperfect systems.
- For our impatience with those who come from different backgrounds, and face different and often unseen challenges.
- For our failure to show compassion and be flexible in friendship, with those who have different cultural priorities and ways of valuing others.

PLEASE

Pray for parents raising children in cross-cultural settings that:

- God would give parents wisdom, patience, grace, and courage as they raise children shaped by both their family heritage and Australian society.
- Parents would pass on what is good, true, and beautiful from their culture, while ultimately raising their children in the training and instruction of the Lord.
- Parents would not be driven by fear, shame, comparison, or control, but by the grace and truth of Christ.

Pray for biblical wisdom and healthy boundaries in family life that:

- They would find their deepest identity not in culture, achievement,

popularity, or fitting in, but in being loved and secure in Christ.

- They would grow in confidence to honour their family background without feeling ashamed, confused, or divided between different worlds.
- They would have safe spaces at home, church, and youth/kids' groups to speak honestly about identity, pressure, faith, and belonging.

Pray for biblical wisdom and healthy boundaries in family life that:

- God would help families discern where cultural expectations around achievement, obedience, shame, reputation, or extended-family pressure may become heavy burdens.
- Parents and children would honour one another rightly, while remembering that Christ is Lord over every culture, family system, and household.
- Families would grow in patterns of love that are sacrificial but not controlling, committed but not fear-driven, and respectful but honest.

Pray for families feeling cultural tension that:

- Homes would be marked by grace, truth, listening, repentance, and love, rather than fear, shame, control, or resentment.
- Families will find a helpful rhythm as they navigate differing cultural values and expectations
- Parents and children would learn to speak honestly and gently with one another, especially around

expectations, friendships, study, dating, career, and faith.

- Cultural differences would become opportunities for deeper understanding and discipleship, rather than sources of distance or conflict.

Pray for St Bart's to grow in humility and understanding that:

- Those from the majority Australian culture would listen deeply and seek to understand the hidden pressures, sacrifices, and joys of cross-cultural families.
- Our church would welcome people not merely by being friendly on Sundays, but by making space for deeper friendship, hospitality, and shared life.
- We would honour one another above ourselves, learning to notice those who may feel unseen, misunderstood, or on the edge of church community.
- The Cultural Connection would be a place where people from different nations, cultures and languages genuinely experience the love of Christ and true belonging and that it would be a safe place to be seen, valued and encouraged.
- Migrant, refugee, and cross-cultural families would experience St Bart's as a safe and loving church family where they are seen, heard, and valued.
- They would be open to receiving friendship, care, and encouragement, rather than withdrawing through hurt, fear, or feeling misunderstood.
- They would contribute their gifts, wisdom, stories, and faith to the wider

body of Christ, knowing they are not guests but fellow members.

Pray for a richer view of Christian community right across Toowoomba & Brisbane that:

- Those who have been shaped by more individualistic cultures would grow in biblical hospitality, interdependence, practical care, and commitment to one another.
- Those shaped by more communal cultures would grow in gospel freedom, honesty, grace, and courage to speak openly rather than simply carrying burdens silently.
- St Bart's would become a community where different cultures are neither ignored nor idolised but brought under the lordship of Christ.
- The language barriers, misunderstandings and cultural assumptions would not divide people, but instead be opportunities for patience, growth and love.

Pray for St Bart's to reflect God's heart for all nations that:

- Our church would be united not by cultural sameness, political ideals, or human wisdom, but by the reconciling work of Christ.
- St Bart's would increasingly reflect the biblical future of people from every nation, tribe, people, and language worshipping together before the Lamb.
- Our unity in Christ would become a visible witness to Toowoomba of God's grace, wisdom, and kingdom.

AREA FOUR: EVANGELISM

Making Disciples of Jesus

As part of our response to the great commission, part of our mission as a church is to help people become followers of Jesus. We long and pray for people to put their trust in Jesus as Saviour and Lord. We take our part in the power of God's Spirit, joining in with what is God's ultimate work.

THANK YOU

- For all who have witnessed to us, prayed for us, and discipled us in our faith. Also for the privilege we share in doing the same.
- For those in our church (young, old, and in between) who have become followers of Jesus or come back to faith last year.
- For the wonderful opportunities to share the Gospel with many people who don't yet know Jesus over Easter.
- For those recently baptised (Bob & Memphis) and reaffirmed their baptism vows (Gloria), for their witness to God's work in their lives.

- For the ten people who explored faith through Alpha earlier this year. Pray that they would each trust in Jesus as their Lord and Saviour, and they would have deep foundations for life-long following of Jesus.
- For the people who don't yet know Jesus, who have come along to a service in Salisbury and in Toowoomba.
- For those who have expressed interest in exploring faith further, or significantly returning to faith.
- For the opportunities on all of our frontlines to both show and share the Good News of Jesus.
- That we have incredible freedom in Australia to proclaim the Gospel without the fear of persecution.
- For the growing openness to faith we are witnessing in our community.
- That many—people who are not yet believers—who feel welcome to join us on Sundays (in-person and online).
- For the opportunity to share the Gospel with children and youth each week, at Kids Club & CHARGE Youth.

SORRY

- For when we fail to take seriously nor actively pray for our part in the proclamation of the Gospel.
- For when we have grown tired or apathetic towards sharing the Good News with other people.
- For when we think it is impossible that God could change the hearts of those we love.
- For times in which we have been timid in sharing our faith.

PLEASE

- Embolden us with the Spirit to recognise Gospel opportunities, have the wisdom in knowing what to say, and the courage to actually speak.
- For God to prepare the hearts to whom we go that they might be receptive to inviting and the Good News.
- Give us eyes to see who we might invite to church, courage to invite, and that the Spirit would be preparing hearts now to accept an invitation.
- For continued conversations with family, friends, and neighbours who came along to an Easter service - for wisdom, compassion, and gentleness in pointing to Jesus.
- That we will embrace the many opportunities in Aged Care to share the Good News and invite people to put their trust in the Lord Jesus.
- That those who are not yet believers and connect with our Sunday services and/or various ministries will continue to grow in their faith and become followers of Jesus. Help us to be proactive in taking our part in discipling new believers.
- For those preparing for baptism and confirmation this year.
- That our church plant will be an active Gospel-sharing community.
- That as a church we will be growing in active involvement in evangelism. Pray that each member of St Bart's would invite one person along to Alpha with them.
- That we would have a sense of urgency to share the Gospel actively in and through our lives.

THANK YOU

- For the phenomenal leaders — serving across a range of areas — who help lead the mission and ministry of our church.
- For the diversity of people in leadership and serving roles and the enormous gifts that God has entrusted to them. Give thanks for how those gifts are poured out.
- For the ways we can grow as leaders together. Give thanks particularly for those leaders who have served for a long time and seek to continually grow. Give thanks also for leaders recently appointed.

- For the appointment of a Church Planter in Brisbane (Michael Marklew), and for the extraordinary continuing team.
- For the commitment to raising up gospel workers, and the contribution of our new and continuing interns.
- *Gatherings*: For the opportunity to hear God's Word read, proclaimed, and expounded every week.
- *Gatherings*: For the goodness of God's Word and the privilege it is to gather around God's Word together.

- *Operations*: For all who serve to help us be faithful stewards of our finances. For the incredible generosity and consistency of people who give of their financial resources.
- *Mission Partnerships*: For the opportunity to partner with our Mission Partners in prayer & finances.
- *Governance & Parish Council*: For those who serve faithfully to ensure good governance and look to the long-term vision of our church. For the various subcommittees who work tirelessly.

SORRY

- For the ways in which we hurt each other, fail to consider one another needs, or carry one another's burdens.
- For when we've failed to identify people's gifts and help them to exercise them in God's church.
- For when we skip on responsibilities in the building up of God's people.

- When we can't see the need before us.
- We lament that many who have been hurt by Christian community find it hard to connect to any local church.
- We lament that so many people have not yet put their trust in Jesus and do not know the security of the salvation that he has won for us.
- For when we've missed opportunities to connect people deeper into the Body of Christ. For when we rely on our own means instead of the power of God's Spirit.
- For when our vision of the future is out of step with God's. For when our vision does not match the size of God's vision for our church.

PLEASE

- That God would make us wise in his ways, not least in leadership.
- That God would protect our leaders and equip them.
- That God would raise up more leaders to serve in key areas.
- For continued guidance on how best to identify, equip, encourage, and strengthen leaders in the gospel.
- Help us to grow our giving to meet the needs of our budget this year, and to respond to the ways the Lord has answered our prayer in the provision of ministers for Toowoomba and Brisbane.
- For those entering into discernment towards ordination: that they will take the steps where God leads.
- Pray that the Lord would be readying the Marklew family to move to Brisbane. Pray especially for the community to receive them well and that a house would be available in ample time for the move.
- *Gatherings:* That we would in the power of God's Spirit, keep growing in our knowledge of God's Word, in our love for God, and our obedience in all of the ways that he instructs us.
- *Gatherings:* For every congregation to continue to grow in discipleship, mission, and service. Particularly pray that many will come to put their trust in the Lord.
- *Gatherings:* Pray also that people who have drifted from faith and the life of community (wherever that may be), would return. Pray in the Lord's kindness that we would share in that work.
- *Gatherings:* For God to continue to raise up people to serve.
- *Gatherings:* As we continue to grow, pray that God will give wisdom in appointing key leaders for each congregation to help nurture the health and mission of our church.
- *Gatherings:* That as we update our serving pathway, that this would truly be helpful in enabling people to take their part in the building up of God's church (more simply, consistently, and readily). Pray this would also be enabling for team leaders.
- *Gatherings:* For wisdom as we continue to nurture the online community connected to St Bart's. Pray that the digital team would be inspired and equipped with every good gift from above for all that they need in this important ministry.

- *Gatherings:* That God would send people, especially with musical gifts, to be part of the church plant team.
- *Gatherings:* That we would be faithful in our handling of God's Word — through every ministry.
- *Gatherings:* For those who preach: that they would be energised, inspired, encouraged, and protected.
- *Gatherings:* For our series in Romans to be effective in strengthening people in the gospel. Pray also that many will come to 'confess with their mouth and believe in their heart that Jesus is Lord and that God has raised him from the dead' (cf. Romans 10).
- *Gatherings:* May our service and heart to care for others extend to those unfamiliar with the gospel and may they feel the love of Christ through it.
- *Gatherings:* For people to assist with the design of our artwork used in preaching series.
- *Gatherings:* Help us to warmly welcome new people, encourage them in faith, and connect them in our life together.
- *Gatherings - Music:* For guidance, wisdom and ongoing unity in purpose and in Christ for our teams across all the congregations, as we seek to serve the church by pointing them to Jesus.
- *Gatherings:* Raise up more musicians and singers, particularly for the 6PM congregation. For God's wisdom to the team leaders, in caring for their music teams, and choosing helpful songs.
- *Gatherings:* To cultivate and grow a servant's heart and a willingness to share gifts through hospitality.
- *Gatherings:* For more willing volunteers to join the tech team across all services. For wisdom and calmness when unexpected technical issues arise. For unity, creativity, and joy in the tech team as we serve together.
- *Gatherings:* To grow our hospitality and welcome teams, especially after the 9:30AM Toowoomba service.
- *Gatherings:* To grow the number of people serving within the Altar Guild.
- *Gatherings - Bus:* For additional buggy drivers to help those requiring assistance in attending the morning services.
- *Gatherings:* For the Holy Spirit to guide us to be aware of any wishing to attend services at St Bart's but need help to do so.
- *Gatherings:* For a growth in passengers and bus drivers.
- *Gatherings:* Create a welcoming space that encourages visitors to return and to grow in Christ.
- *Children, Youth, & Families - mainly music:* For the Lord to grant us patience and a playful spirit to guide all participants with kindness and harmony and encourage us to model our true love for God throughout these sessions.
- *Children, Youth, & Families:* That children and youth would share the love and words of Jesus with friends and peers.
- *Children, Youth, & Families:* For those interested or wanting to be prepared for baptism & confirmation this year.
- *Children, Youth, & Families:* For our continued involvement in the TAS Chapel team. Pray for wisdom and

opportunities to strengthen this partnership in the Boarding Houses, staff, and leadership.

- *Children, Youth, & Families:* For volunteers to be raised up for Sunday Children's Ministry (both in Toowoomba and Brisbane).
- *Children, Youth, & Families:* For continued ability to make our ministry spaces and programs as accessible as possible so that all children and youth may be able to engage with the Gospel.
- *Children, Youth, & Families:* For the recruitment of more people to the resource-writing team.
- *Children, Youth, & Families:* That we might continue to be intentional about raising up the next generation of Church leaders who are passionate about Jesus Christ.
- *Children, Youth, & Families:* That God will raise up more RI instructors from across our churches so that there are enough classes offered for the needs in our schools.
- *Children, Youth, & Families:* For the upcoming CHARGE Youth Mission Trip to Lightning Ridge - that it may be an encouraging time for those who attend, for the Lightning Ridge Community Church, and for the Langmeads.
- *Children, Youth, & Families:* Help us navigate how to best disciple our Senior youth and those finishing their final years of school. May God grant wisdom as we seek to know how to best encourage and support them to lean into God during this period of transitioning from teen to adult.

- *Children, Youth, & Families:* We pray for those who are exhausted from parenting - either physically or emotionally. May God sustain and strengthen them and provide the right people to walk alongside and support them. Above all, may they be reminded that "He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak." (Isaiah 40:29)
- *St Bart's Care:* For the many residents of Symes Thorpe who are nearing the end of life but still don't know Jesus.
- *St Bart's Care:* For the St Bart's team visiting residents in Symes Thorpe regularly, that God would give them wisdom and sensitivity in their conversations and opportunities to talk about Jesus.
- *St Bart's Care:* That God would be at work through the services in Aged Care homes, that many would be comforted by the love of God and trust in Jesus.
- *St Bart's Care:* That everyone in need will know the love and care of God through his people.
- *St Bart's Care:* Help us not to forget those who are less visible, heal according to your will & purposes, and that those who are in need may know the tenderness and presence of God.

- *Discipleship & Training:* For more volunteers to join the dedicated library team.
- *Discipleship & Training:* For people to grow in their love of God through his Word through Ridley Certificate.
- *Discipleship & Training:* For the Lord to raise up people to be part of the in-person Ridley team.
- *Discipleship & Training:* That we would be active in proclaiming the Gospel on our frontline of work. That people would be equipped to see how God is at work through their work, especially through the Centre for Work + Faith.
- *Discipleship & Training:* Use the Prayer Nights to help us partake in God's mission in the world. Connect more people into regular prayer ministries such as groups, chats, and lists.
- *Discipleship & Training:* That our Newcomer's lunches would be effective and helpful in linking people into our life together.
- *Operations:* For more gardeners to lighten the load of the current team and replace those getting too old to manage the physical work.
- *Operations:* For more people to serve in with the Operations team.
- *Operations:* For the mowing team, that the Lord would keep everyone safe in every way when doing this work, often on their own.
- *Operations:* That as a church, we would all give generously and sacrificially of our finances, intentionally committing to building God's kingdom, together.
- *Operations:* For an increase in giving, in response to how God has provided additional ministers.
- *Leadership:* Encouragement for all in leading ministry teams, for clarity in each person's role and a healthy work-life rhythm.
- *Governance & Parish Council:* That we would be good stewards in all areas, faithful in governance, and wise in seeking God's will for our future.
- *Mission Partnerships:* That our vision for those who don't know Christ in our community, Australia, and other nations of the world, will be enlarged.

Identifying, encouraging, developing, and sending Gospel workers has long been part of the mission of our church. Pray for the multiplication of Gospel workers, and the multiplication of disciple-making communities - beginning with the Church Plant in Salisbury, Brisbane.
